「榮神益人」是協同的創校精神，培養「僕人式領袖」是協同的教育目標。今年暑假帶領八位"模聯社"的協同學生，前往日內瓦參加針對國立中正大學和日本名古屋大學所設計的課程「Geneva Programme on Global Leadership」，這個課程由日內瓦非營利組織「The Center for Socio-Eco-Nomic Development」負責規劃，以聯合國 2015 年 10 月公佈的 17 個永續發展目標(Sustainable Development Goals)為課程核心。

十天的課程圍繞這個主軸，早上就各類議題請相關專家、學者或教授講課，並分組討論報告，下午參訪相關國際組織。例如：早上談國際貿易、環境變遷、勞工、人權議題....，下午就對應安排參訪 WTO、國際氣象組織、國際勞工組織、國際兒童人權組織、聯合國....，這些國際組織沒有特別安排申請，平常一般人很難參訪，更難得安排在正式會議室有專人引導簡介，讓學生親臨國際組織開會實況。

整體課程設計得非常精彩，學生相當於聽了十幾堂博士級專家的專題演講，雖然內容比較難，但協同學生的英文程度非常好，跟大學生研究生一起聽課，討論，提問，發表，毫無障礙，教授學者對協同學生的英文能力相當訝異，對他們的表現都讚譽有加。

我期待這個優質的課程能持續舉辦，讓英文程度好的學生除了遊學團之外，有不同的選擇，自我挑戰展現英文能力。並且計劃將聯合國頒佈的永續發展目標（17 SDGs）融入協同的課程，培養協同的孩子從年輕就能關心在地及全球性的議題：

氣候行動、永續城市、消除貧窮與飢餓、健康與福祉、和平與正義、全球夥伴...
培養協同學生成為具有「在地關懷及國際視野的僕人式領袖」。
